

BOLOGNA AIRPORT: ONE MILLION PASSENGERS IN JUNE (+8.9% ON JUNE 2023)

New record month for Bologna Marconi Airport: in June passengers exceeded one million, reaching 1,070,021, up 8.9% on the same month of 2023. Beaten the results of summer 2023, June 2024 becomes the month with the highest level of passenger traffic in the entire history of the airport.

In detail, passengers on domestic flights recorded the greatest increases (278,262, +10.5% on June 2023), but passengers on international flights also recorded a good performance (791,759, +8.4% on June 2023). Movements also grew, but less, to 7,553 (+7.5%), and freight, equal to 3,847 tons (+10.8%).

The destinations preferred by Marconi passengers were: Catania, Tirana, Barcelona, Palermo, Paris CDG, Brindisi, Istanbul, Cagliari, Madrid and Frankfurt. The busiest day was Sunday 30 June, with 43,266 passengers between arrivals and departures.

In the first half of 2024, total passengers were 5 million, 5,039,552 to be precise, with an increase of 10.0% on the same period of 2023, while movements were 36,957, up by 7.6% on 2023.

Freight in the period January-June were 22,590 tons, with an increase of 8.2% on 2023.

Aeroporto Guglielmo Marconi di Bologna, classified as a "strategic airport" in the centre-north area of the National Airports Plan prepared by the Ministry of Infrastructure and Transport, recorded in 2023 around 10 million passengers, ranking as the seventh biggest Italian airport by number of passengers (Source: Assaeroporti – Aeroporti2030). Located in the heart of the Emilian food valley and the automotive and packaging industrial districts, the airport has a catchment area of about 11 million inhabitants and around 47,000 companies, with a strong propensity to exports and internationalisation and with commercial expansion policies to Eastern Europe and Asia.

As for airport infrastructure, the airport has among its strategic objectives in the next few years an important development plan that mainly concerns the expansion of the terminal, particularly in the parts of security checks and gate area. The company's aim is to make Bologna Airport one of the most modern and functional in Italy, an important gateway to the city and region.
