

## BOLOGNA AIRPORT: 640 THOUSAND PASSENGERS IN FEBRUARY, NEVER SO MANY IN THE SECOND MONTH OF THE YEAR

Another positive month for Bologna Marconi Airport: in February there were **643,005** passengers, with an increase of **12.0%** on the same month of 2024.

In detail, both **passengers on national flights (152,837, +11.1%** on February 2024) and **passengers on international flights (490,168, +12.3%** on the same month last year) are growing. **Movements, at 4,775**, also recorded an increase over 2024 (+7.4%), while freight, equal to 3,464 tons, were decreasing (-4.6%).

Considering that **2024 was a leap year**, **with 29 days in February**, if we compare the two months with the same number of days - the first 28 of February 2024 - the numbers for February 2025 are even more important, with a growth in passengers of 15.2% and an increase in flights of 10.5%.

**The "most flown" destinations in February 2025** were: Catania, Barcelona, Tirana, Madrid, Paris Charles De Gaulle, Palermo, Bucharest, Istanbul, Rome Fiumicino and London Heathrow.

In the first two months of the year, total passengers were 1,317,961, up 9.0% on the same period in 2024, while movements were 9,855, up 4.4% on the two-month period of 2024.

Freight in January and February were 6,767 tons, down 5.1% on the same period in 2024.

**Aeroporto Guglielmo Marconi di Bologna,** classified as a "strategic airport" in the centre-north area of the National Airports Plan prepared by the Ministry of Infrastructure and Transport, recorded in 2024 10.8 million passengers, ranking as the seventh biggest Italian airport by number of passengers (Source: Assaeroporti – Aeroporti2030). Located in the heart of the Emilian food valley and the automotive and packaging industrial districts, the airport has a catchment area of about 11 million inhabitants and around 47,000 companies, with a strong propensity to exports and internationalisation and with commercial expansion policies to Eastern Europe and Asia.

As for airport infrastructure, the airport has among its strategic objectives in the next few years an important development plan that mainly concerns the expansion of the terminal, particularly in the gate area. The company's aim is to make Bologna Airport one of the most modern and functional in Italy, an important gateway to the city and region.
